

## EUROSAI ITWG Training Programme “Auditing AI in the Public Sector” Certificate Issuance Statute

1. The purpose of the EUROSAI ITWG training programme "Auditing AI in the Public Sector" is to equip auditors with the knowledge and skills necessary to effectively audit AI systems in government, ensuring that these systems are implemented responsibly, ethically, and securely.
2. The training programme is offered in a Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) format and is completed as e-learning.
3. The training programme consists of 4 modules:
  - Introduction to AI and Its Implications in Government (developed by the National Audit Office of Estonia, the Court of Audit of the Republic of Slovenia and the U.S. Government Accountability Office);
  - Security and Data in AI Systems (developed by the National Audit Office of Estonia, the Office of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the U.S. Government Accountability Office);
  - Auditing AI Systems: Frameworks and Methodologies (developed by the National Audit Office of Estonia, the Office of the State Comptroller and Ombudsman of Israel, the Court of Audit of the Republic of Slovenia, the Swiss Federal Audit Office and the Netherlands Court of Audit);
  - Future Trends and Continuous Learning (developed by the Accountability State Authority of Egypt, the Office of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, the Moroccan Court of Accounts, the State Financial and Administrative Audit Authority of Oman, the National Audit Chamber of the Republic of Sudan).
4. It takes approximately the following time to acquire the content of the modules of the training programme:
  - Introduction to AI and Its Implications in Government (equivalent to 10 hours)
  - Security and Data in AI Systems (equivalent to 15 hours)
  - Auditing AI Systems: Frameworks and Methodologies (equivalent to 20 hours)
  - Future Trends and Continuous Learning (equivalent to 15 hours)
5. "Approximate time to acquire the content" has only informative meaning.
6. The student passes a module upon achieving a mark of at least 75% in the final test of the module, a badge is issued for individual modules.



7. The training programme certificate is issued to a person who has completed all 4 modules. The name of the participant, the completed modules and their approximate time, as well as the certificate issuance number and date are indicated on the certificate.
8. The certificate of the training programme is issued and registered by the National Audit Office of Estonia.
9. The certificate does not expire.
